Theological Dictionary of the New Testament, 10 Volumes

Bromiley / Eerdmans Publishing Co. / 1964 This monster-size work offers information about the way important NT Greek words are used, not only in the NT, but also in Classical and Koine Greek literature, and in the ancient Greek translation of the Hebrew OT (Septuagint). Available both in print (10 volumes) or CD-ROM. This is not the same version offered as a single volume abridged theological dictionary (the "Little Kittel").
