# What is ILDA?



The International Lutheran Deaf Association was founded in Chicago during the first biennial convention in 1971. The purpose, according to the revised constitution, is "to coordinate and strengthen the religious activities and services in our congregation to help promote their growth to the highest possible level in service to their Lord and Savior, to promote the Christian faith and life of Lutheran Deaf people, all deaf individuals, and others with whom we associate; and to carry on our ministry throughout the world. "

The I.L.D.A. shall communicate and convey to the deaf members, the programs, plans and goals of the Lutheran Church-Missouri Synod. It shall support lay-leadership among deaf Lutherans in all areas of faith and life.

The 1975, the members voted ratification of the revised constitution. The historic document will help develop the I.L.D.A. image and facilitate the operation and administration of the association. The members also supported the goal of recruiting as many lay people as possible and getting them activity involved in the I.L.D.A affairs.

In 1987, the aim of I.L.D.A. is to carry out the objectives of serving the Lord in His church and to obtain the financial support that would lead to self-sufficiency. It is hoped that many programs and projects for the ministry and mission of the I.L.D.A. will become a reality.

Membership in the I.D.L.A. is open to all deaf, and is divided into three categories: ACTIVE, ASSOCIATE, and SUSTAINING.

The I.L.D.A. relies on its official publication, THE DEAF LUTHERAN, to convey information of its activities and services to deaf Lutherans.

# God's 1,000 Club

God's 1,000 Club was established by the I.L.D.A. Board of Directors and it aims to continue to grow.

The name "God's 1,000 Club" was chosen because, first of all, the work of I.L.D.A. is to get the Good News of God's Son to the deaf everywhere 1,000 represented the number of donors or club members, we hope to enlist.

People who become members in God's 1,000 Club are asked to contribute \$20.00 each year thereafter. This is not part of the regular I.L.D.A. dues and it does not pay for a subscription to THE DEAF LUTHERAN. Any donations given to "God's 1,000 Club, can only be used to help pay the expenses of I.L.D.A. board meetings.

# <u>Lutheran Church Work Among</u> <u>the Deaf in British Columbia</u>

~1929~

Rev. Victor L. Meyer, pastor of Bethlehem Lutheran Church, Vancouver, B. C., William Reid, Alex and Laura Brodie made a special trip to Seattle to invite Rev. George Gaertner to Vancouver, B.C. to conduct regular services in Vancouver. Rev. Gaertner conducted the first service in Vancouver in November. Regular quarterly, monthly, or more frequent services were conducted at Bethlehem Lutheran Church in Vancouver.

~1931~

Rev. Walter A. Westermann succeeded Dr. Gaertner.

#### ~1935~

The first adult class received into membership by confirmation.

#### ~1942~

Rev. Arnold T. Jonas succeeded Rev. Westermann.

~1948~

Rev. Walter J. Hintz succeeded Rev. Jonas.

#### ~1949~

Rev. John A. Beyer succeeded Rev. Hintz.

#### ~1959~

Vancouver Deaf group was organized as Trinity Lutheran Church for the Deaf.

#### ~1961~

Martin A. Hewitt, student-pastor was placed as a vicar, the first resident worker among the Deaf in Vancouver. The services was held in Vancouver, Surrey, Richmond and Victoria. The first Bible class for children at Jericho Hill School for the Deaf was established. Lutheran Youth Fellowship of the Deaf was established.

#### ~1962~

The Deaf Lutheran services by the preceded pastor in Seattle and Vancouver were divided. Rev. Wayne C. Bottlinger was installed as the first resident ordained pastor. Services moved to Killarney Park Lutheran Church, E. 49th Ave. and Lancaster. Regular night services began in Mt. Calvary Lutheran Church in New Westminster.

#### ~1963~

The Women's "Doras Circle" was begun. The new constitution was adopted by the congregation. Classes at Woodlands School and regular visits at Riverview Hospital began.

#### ~1964~

The Building Committee was chosen and the site was purchased at the corner of School Avenue and College Street at 2900 Kingsway. The first camp week for Deaf children was held.

#### ~1965~

Mr. Alex M. Brodie was appointed as a part-time volunteer Lay Worker.

J. M. Schmidt Associates chosen as architects for a new building.

#### ~1966~

Mr. Alex M. Brodie was commissioned as a full-time Lay Worker.

Mr. Tony Bisig was commissioned to sculpture an altar.

#### ~1967~

Carlson and Hartup Construction Company was awarded building contract.

Sod Turning Ceremony was held on March 15th

Cornerstone Laying Ceremony was held on April 30th.

The dedication of the building was dated on September 10th.

#### ~1970~

Rev. Wayne C. Bottlinger assumed full-time position at Jericho Hill School for the Deaf but continued as pastor of Trinity Lutheran Church for the Deaf without pay from the church. Mr. Alex M. Brodie became a volunteer lay worker. The church no longer received subsidy.

#### ~1973~

Rev. Fredrick P. Gehrs of Winnipeg Lutheran Church had moved to reside in the Greater Vancouver and became a full-time pastor of the Trinity Lutheran Church for the Deaf.

#### ~1978~

Trinity Lutheran Church for the Deaf became an official member of the Alberta-British Columbia (ABC) District of the Lutheran Church — Missouri Synod.

#### ~1985~

Rev. Frederick P. Gehrs resigned. The subsidy from Alberta-British Columbia District stopped. Rev. Wayne C. Bottlinger returned to be a vacant pastor without pay.

#### ~1989~

Rev. Wayne C. Bottlinger was installed as a pastor of Trinity Lutheran Church for the Deaf. The building at School Avenue and College Street was sold. The services moved to Killarney Park Lutheran Church, 49th Avenue and Lancaster. Monies were received for building investment. No subsidy was received. Trinity Lutheran Church became an official member of Lutheran Church — Canada.

#### ~1994~

The Trinity Lutheran Church of the Deaf celebrated its 65th Anniversary with a dinner with about 100 people in attendance. Old photos from church archives were exhibited by chairman David Sullivan. The invited pastors were Rev. M. Hewitt, Rev. Bauer, Rev. Ludwig from Spokane, Seattle and Edmonton.

#### ~1999~

Rev. David S. Nielsen, a *deaf* pastor was installed as a full-time pastor of Trinity Lutheran Church for the Deaf. Services and Bible Classes were held at Killarney Park Lutheran Church in Vancouver, St. Luke Lutheran in Surrey, and Trinity Lutheran in Abbotsford. The ministry was funded by the offering of members, interest from funds invested in Church Extension and some subsidy from Alberta-British Columbia (ABC) District.

#### ~2003~

The name of the church was changed to Trinity Lutheran Church <u>of</u> the Deaf.

#### ~2004~

Trinity Lutheran Church of the Deaf celebrated its 75th Anniversary with a dinner at St. Luke Lutheran Church in Surrey with about 80 people in attendance. Many old photos from church archives were exhibited. Rev. Dennis Konkel, a *deaf* pastor from Iowa was the guest speaker. Invited pastors were Rev. W. Ludwig a *deaf* pastor, Rev. Fred Gehrs and Emeritus Rev. Bottlinger from Seattle, Chilliwack, and Vancouver.

#### ~2005~

The 18th Biennial Convention of the International Lutheran Deaf Association (ILDA) was hosted by Trinity Lutheran Church of the Deaf, Vancouver, in Burnaby, British Columbia from August 3rd to 7th. This is the first ILDA convention outside the U.S.A. and the first in Canada.
