



ILDA INFORMATION

OUR MISSION

ILDA IS AN ORGANIZATION COMMITTED TO SPREADING THE GOSPEL OF JESUS CHRIST AMONG DEAF AND HARD OF HEARING PEOPLE THROUGH MISSION WORK IN THE U.S. AND AROUND THE WORLD. IN OUR LOCAL CONGREGATIONS, WE WORK TOGETHER TO TELL THE DEAF PEOPLE IN OUR COMMUNITIES ABOUT THE SALVATION WE HAVE IN JESUS. OUR MAIN FOCUS IS TO SUPPORT LUTHERAN MISSION WORK WITH DEAF PEOPLE IN OTHER COUNTRIES. WE SUPPORT THEM WITH OUR MONEY, PRAYERS, AND PEOPLE TO DO THE WORK.

WHAT IS ILDA?

THE INTERNATIONAL LUTHERAN DEAF ASSOCIATION IS A FELLOWSHIP OF CHRISTIANS WHO HAVE JOINED TOGETHER TO ENCOURAGE ONE ANOTHER TO GROW IN GOD'S WORD AND TO BEING THAT WORD TO THE WORLD. OUR MEMBERS ARE PRIMARILY FROM DEAF CONGREGATIONS OF THE LUTHERAN CHURCH-MISSOURI SYNOD, WHERE WE WORSHIP IN AMERICAN SIGN LANGUAGE. ALSO AMONG US ARE DEAF MEMBERS OF HEARING CHURCHES WHICH PROVIDE ACCESS THROUGH ASL INTERPRETERS.

ILDA BEGAN ITS MINISTRY IN 1971, HOLDING ITS FIRST BIENNIAL CONVENTION IN CHICAGO. WORKING IN PARTNERSHIP WITH THE LUTHERAN CHURCH—MISSOURI SYNOD AND THE LUTHERAN DEAF MISSION SOCIETY, WE DESIRE TO BE FAITHFUL PEOPLE OF GOD, LED BY HIM AND DUR BLESSED SAVIOR, JESUS CHRIST INSPIRED BY HIS WORD. WE ASPIRE TO ENCOURAGE FAITH AND CHRISTIAN SERVICE IN DUR AFFILIATED CONGREGATIONS AND TO PROMOTE THE GOSPEL OF CHRIST AMONG THE DEAF EVERYWHERE. WE STRIVE TO ENRICH THE LIVES OF DEAF PEOPLE THROUGH SPIRITUAL GROWTH AND TO DEVELOP CHRISTIAN LEADERSHIP AMONG ALL WITH WHOM AND WE ASSOCIATE.

WITH OVER FOURTH YEARS OF FAITHFUL SERVICE, THE INTERNATIONAL LUTHERAN DEAF ASSOCIATION OFFERS PRAISE TO THE LORD OF THE CHURCH FOR THE MANY ACCOMPLISHMENTS IT HAS BEEN PERMITTED TO ACHIEVE AND BLESSINGS UPON ITS MINISTRY.

WHAT IS ILDA DOING?

WITH OVER \$350,000 IN MISSION PROJECT FUNDED SINGE ITS INCEPTION IN 1971, BOTH AT HOME AND ABOARD, ILDA CONTINUES ITS MISSION OF CHRISTIAN SERVICE. EVERY TWO YEARS ILDA SELECTS PROJECTS TO SUPPORT FROM THE LIST OF APPLICANTS. IN PAST YEARS WE HAVE SUPPORTED DEAF EDUCATION AND LEADERSHIP TRAINING IN GHANA, INDIA AND MAGAU, SUMMER CAMP FOR DEAF CHILDREN, YOUTH SERVICE PROJECT, EDUCATION AND REHABILITATION FOR CHALLENGED DEAF ADULTS, THE DEAF INSTITUTE OF THEOLOGY, AND SCHOLARSHIPS FOR INDIVIDUALS PREPARING FOR FULL TIE SERVICE IN LUTHERAN DEAF MINISTRY. SOME OF THESE PROJECTS CONTINUE TO RECEIVE ONGOING SUPPORT THROUGH ILDA'S MISSION PROGRAM, WHILE WE ARE ALRT FOR NEW OPPORTUNITIES FOR SERVICE AND OUTREACH.

WORKING IN PARTNERSHIP WITH CONGREGATIONS OF THE LUTHERAN CHURCH-MISSOURI SYNOD AND THE LUTHERAN DEAF ASSOCIATION ENDEAVORS TO PROMOTE SPIRITUAL GROWTH AND CHRISTIAN SERVICE AMONG ITS MEMBERSHIP. WE ALSO SEEK TO GIVE GREATER VISIBILITY TO THOSE OUTSIDE THE HEARING CHURCH AND DEMONSTRATE THEIR ABILITY TO ADMINISTER THEIR OWN MINISTERIAL PROGRAMS.

AS THE LCMS, LAUNCHES INTO HER SECOND CENTURY OF BRINGING GOD'S WORD TO DEAF PEOPLE IN THEIR OWN LANGUAGE, THE INTERNATIONAL LUTHERAN DEAF ASSOCIATION CONFIDENTLY FACES THE CHALLENGE OF ADDING OUR SUPPORT TO THE CHURCH'S MISSION.

REALIZING THAT GOD OPENS DOORS OF OPPORTUNITY WHERE WE CAN BE OF SERVICE TO HIM, ILDA WILL CONTINUE ITS MISSION OF OUTREACH WHEREVER SUCH OPPORTUNITIES EXIST.



FACT 3

MOVING ALONG, DID YOU KNOW THAT JAMES MADISON IS THE MAN BEHIND THE NAME OF THE CAPITAL OF WISCONSIN? HE IS THE UNITED STATES' FOURTH PRESIDENT. - LAKE KEGONSA IS THE LAKE THAT REFERS TO FISH.
- LAKE WINGRA IS COMMONLY KNOWN TO BE THE LAKE OF THE DEAD.

FACT 7

MADISON HAS AN IMPRESSIVE NUMBER OF BICYCLISTS IN ITS CITY WHO ENJOY THE BIKE PATHS THAT STRETCH NEARLY ONE HUNDRED MILES. THERE ARE AMAZING SCENIC ROUTES ALONG THE BIKE TRAIL LOOP OF LAKE MONONA AND THE LIW ARBORETUM - AMONG OTHER TRAILS. SOME PEOPLE IN THE LOCAL AREA EVEN TEND TO THINK THAT BICYCLES OUTNUMBER VEHICLES WITHIN THE CITY OF MADISON.

FACT 8

IN ADDITION, MADISON IS HOME TO ERIC HEIDEN (SPEED-SKATING'S OLYMPIC GOLD MEDALIST) AND JOHN BARDEEN (SCIENTIST TO WIN THE NOBEL PRIZE). BARDEEN EVEN HAD A HAND IN THE INVENTION OF THE TRANSISTOR. AND THORNTON WILDER'S HOME IS MADISON. HE IS AN AUTHOR WHO WAS AWARDED THE PULITZER PRIZE FOR PLAYWRIGHT.

FACT 9

IN THE YEAR OF 1967, THE LIFE OF OTIS REDDING ENDED WHEN HIS AIRPLANE OF TWO ENGINES CRASHED INTO THE LAKE OF MONONA. AT THAT TIME, HE WAS ACTUALLY FLYING FROM CLEVELAND, OHIO INTO THE CITY OF MADISON, WISCONSIN. HE WAS TWENTY-SIX YEARS OF AGE. A SIXTIES SONG HE HAD DONE, "DOCK OF THE BAY," IS STILL A SONG TO REMEMBER.

FACT 10

THE OLDEST CITY IN WISCONSIN ISN'T MADISON OR EVEN MILWAUKEE. IT'S ACTUALLY GREEN BAY. ITS ROOTS GO ALL THE WAY BACK TO FRENCH EXPLORER JEAN NICOLET WHO STARTED A SMALL TRADING POST IN 1634. THERE'S A LOT MORE HISTORY TO BE TOLD OF "TITLETOWN" THAN THAT OF THE PACKERS, BUT MOST WISCONSINITES' FAVORITE FACT ABOUT GREEN BAY IS STILL THE 13 WORLD CHAMPIONSHIPS.

FACT 4

THE SWISS CHEESE CAPITOL OF THE WORLD ISN'T LOCATED IN SWITZERLAND, IT'S RIGHT HERE IN WISCONSIN. MONROE IS KNOWN FOR THEIR CHEESE. VISIT MONROE IN SEPTEMBER OF EVERY EVEN NUMBERED YEAR FOR GREEN COUNTY CHEESE DAYS.

FACT 7

OFTEN MISTAKEN AS THE "FORWARD STATUE", THE SCULPTURE AT THE HIGHEST POINT OF THE WISCONSIN'S STATE CAPITOL BUILDING IS OFFICIALLY NAMED "WISCONSIN" BUT HAS ALSO BEEN NICKNAMED THE "GOLDEN LADY".
