Greetings in a special anniversary of 500th-year Reformation

The International Lutheran Deaf Association Board would like to welcome all of you, faithful participants, presenters, guest speakers, clergy, and family members to this special convention featuring a special anniversary of 500th-year Reformation. Please convey your blessings to the host committee for its diligence and much efforts on that special occasion during the 24th ILDA Biennial Convention in Indianapolis! Most importantly, we are thankful to everyone who are supporting the ILDA in the Christian manner. Keep the faith, my sisters and brothers in the name of Jesus.

As you are aware, the entire world is watching this special anniversary of Martin Luther's 500th year Reformation via internet, global television, conventions, churches, social media, and mouth-to-mouth talks. Why it is so special? Historically, nobody challenged the supremacy of the Roman Catholic Church since the Great East-West Schism of 1050 was occurred. Over the centuries anyone who tried to challenge the Papacy was put to death in the most horrible manner and lost their property. The dominance of the Roman Catholic Church stayed unchallenged with fear for nearly five centuries. Until then, on October 31, 1517, Martin Luther's "The 95 Theses" challenged the authority of the Catholic Church. Martin Luther tried to help the Roman Catholic church by eliminating such unChristian practices like selling indulgences for profit for the Vatican. Martin Luther believed that the only path to salvation lay through faithfulness to Christ, not though the ideologies and dogmas of the Catholic Church. However, it is important to understand and remember that Martin Luther was not trying to criticize the Catholic Church. He was trying to get them to stop making off the business of salvation. Luther's 95 Theses spread across Europe like wildfire. Luther suddenly found himself at the centre of the greatest conflict of his age. Two years later, Pope Leo X was not happy with Luther's accusation, so he demanded that Luther recant his heresy or face excommunication. However, Luther burned the Pope's letter and broke all ties with the Roman Catholic Church. This is one of the most critical history records we have learned.

All in all, we are looking forward to sightseeing a marvellous biblical tour, Noah's Ark outside of Indianapolis with entertainment and we are continuing learning God's Word in the name of Jesus Christ. We are excited to mingle and make new friends who share God's Word with each other. After the convention, please bring wonderful words with your extended family members and friends.
