Located adjacent to O'Hare International Airport and the City of Chicago, Elk Grove is an integral component of the Chicago Metropolitan Region's economy. A planned community with approximately 33,000 residents, Elk Grove boasts the largest consolidated business park in North America with over 100 million square feet of

industrial space. <u>Rainbow Falls Waterpark</u> - Rainbow Falls is a great place to cool off on a hot summer day with the family. Some attractions include the Sunfish Bay Lagoon Pool, a whirlpool in Sunfish Bay, four giant Calypso Twist water slides or a leisure raft ride on the Reptile River.

<u>**Pirates' Cove Children's Theme Park</u></u> - The Pirates' Cove Children's Theme Park is sure way to keep young children busy as they climb aboard a pirate ship and pretend to sail the seven seas! Attractions include a play area; a climbing wall, a fun slide, train rides, paddleboats and more.</u>**

Fox Run Golf Links - Fox Run Golf Links features an 18-hole golf course that provides a mix of challenging and forgiving fairways that are enjoyable for recreational and competitive golfers alike.

<u>Audubon Skate Park</u> - The Audubon Skate Park is an indoor skate park featuring 11,000 square feet of ideal terrain for skateboarders and inline skaters of all ages with varying skill levels.
