Now that summer is almost here, and also, some of us will be going to the ILDA Convention at Indianapolis at the end of June, what should we do as orthodox Lutheran Christians in our service to the Lord God? I just remembered one certain biblical verse of which we all should be aware at all times while we live and witness our Christian faith. I Corinthians 10:31 reads:

...whenever you eat or drink or do anything else, do everything to glorify God.

I Corinthians 10 ends that we should not be the reason for others to sin, no matter if they are Jews, Greeks, or God's church ... [we] try to please everyone in every way and don't look for [our selfish reasons] but for ... many people so that they may be saved.

With that in our mind, we ask ourselves how we can live our life that would most please God. The Jews asked Jesus what they should do to please God. Do you know the answer Jesus gave them? The answer is found in John 6:29, which says: What God wants you to do is to believe in [Jesus] Whom [the Lord God] sent.

Of course, the Jews were not satisfied with Jesus' answer and demanded proof that He perform a miracle of some kind before they could believe Him. It turned out that they did not have saving faith in the first place to either believe in Him or please the Lord God in any way. After all, it is impossible to please God without saving faith, no matter how good or sincere a person may be in whatever he/she is doing in the service of people (Isaiah 64:6).

The point I am saying is that in order for us to please God, He alone has grace to create faith in us through Word and Sacrament (Holy Baptism and Lord's Supper) and then empower us to please Him in all what we do to glorify Him. The Holy Spirit works ceaselessly to enlighten us with His gifts and sanctify and keep us in the true faith so that we may faithfully do whatever our Heavenly Father had long ago planned for us in His Beloved Son.

We will work together in the upcoming ILDA convention as brothers and sisters in Christ to find new ways to proclaim the Gospel while staying faithful to the pure proclamation of the Gospel which has the power to save sinners. While we share God's love with all sinners, it is very important for us to keep our eyes always on our Savior who begins and completes our faith (Hebrews 12:2).

Try to avoid a taxicab, as the meter will keep on running even if it stops/waits at construction sites. That will be very expensive!

There will be a table for you to sign up for the return trip to the airport on Sunday, June 21. More information will be given at the convention.

Please send in your ILDA convention and hotel registration forms as soon as possible. We are pleased with the responses from you who already sent in your forms. We thank you for your generous donations to help make the 2001 convention a possibility for you to attend. God answered our prayers !!

They, the students, don't really have a lot to be thankful for, aside from the new school. Their home life is about the same; many still have communication problems and frequent putdowns, etc. However they are learning that they need to be thankful for whatever they get. .

The students worked very hard on their Christmas skit. The play was called "Bah Humbug." It was based on the Scrooge Christmas story but with a Christian twist. Instead of ghosts, we had angels sharing the spirit of Christmas. Cecilia Chan, another teacher at school, and I wrote the script. None of us could believe the day arrived where we had to actually do the play. Everyone seemed to enjoy the play and for that I'm very thankful. Wendy, Gloria, and Bonnie opted to sign a song in American Sign Language instead of doing the play. They did a wonderful job signing "Silent Night" in ASL. They were really eager to learn the song in ASL. The girls want to thank Pastor Matthews for sending the video of Christmas songs in ASL.

On Dec. 20th Bonnie, Gloria, and I took a trip to Zhuhai, China. We stayed at a nice hotel and had our own little Christmas Party. I shared stories of my past Christmases with them. Christmas is only another excuse for a party here in Macau. No one really knows the true meaning of Christmas, except those who are Christians. Everyone else just goes out to party.
