Back to School

Jesus said, "Let the little children come to Me and don't keep them away. The Kingdom of Heaven belongs to such as these." Matthew 19:14

Except for the areas in the country where they have school all year, this is the traditional time for back-to-school. You see the back-to-school sales in many of the stores, newspaper advertisements and TV commercials. Most children are excited to get back to school to see their friends, even if they aren't excited to go back to classrooms, books, homework, tests, reports and all the rest of the work connected with school. Any good parent, though, will make sure the child returns to school and works hard to succeed.

This is also the traditional time for new confirmation classes for children to begin. I was recently given a stack of old *Deaf Lutheran* newspapers from the 1940's and 1950's, and I really enjoy reading through them. I enjoy seeing pictures of the confirmation classes and how I recognize some of those students not as children but now as senior citizens. I am also amazed at the sizes of some of those confirmation classes, some as large as 35 students! I've never had a youth confirmation class with more than three students at a time. Of course, I do realize that back in the 1940's and 1950's, the pastors were allowed to teach the students on the deaf school campus and all children were required to go to religion classes. Some things have

changed over the years and some things haven't changed. Students are no longer required to go to religion classes and most deaf schools don't allow churches to conduct classes on campus anymore. One of the things that hasn't changed is that *every single child is precious in the eyes of God!* When we have one, two or three children in confirmation class, those children are just as precious as the thirty-five students in classes of past years.

It might be harder for us to find the deaf children today, since so many are mainstreamed and no longer going to the state schools for the deaf, but we need to find them and we need to teach them about their Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ. It doesn't have to be a pastor who teaches them about Jesus, any mature Christian can teach them from Luther's Small Catechism. Someone took the time to teach you and lead you to your Savior, can't you now do the same for one of the precious deaf children for whom Jesus died to redeem?

Even though this has talked about children, adults can go back to school, too. The Deaf Institute of Theology (DIT) is a great place to learn more about your Lord and Savior and learn how to share your faith with others. For more information about DIT, go to *www.deafleaders.org*.
