ILDA President's First Message

Greetings to you, my sisters and brothers in the name of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ! It is the first presidential message I have written to you since I am a new officer in Baltimore, Maryland for a two-year term last June.

As my wife, Linda and I are subscribing an array of Lutheran magazines like The Canadian Lutheran, Alberta-British Columbia Lutheran District Newsletter, Trinity Lutheran Church of the Deaf Newsletter, and Thrivent. I am in search of deaf-friendly biblical editorials or commentaries to link to The Deaf Lutheran with relevancy. Writing messages requires me to think clearly and write directly with purpose to serve the Deaf Lutherans throughout North America. From the reliable sources in the Baltimore convention, with much astonishment, I learnt that there are about twenty five present Lutheran pastors in the Deaf churches across the United States. To be truthful with you, it is frightening to see a deteriorating number of pastoral staff with the Deaf Lutherans. Likewise, there are three current fulltime pastors in Western Canada, but the twos are retired beyond the mandatory age. Disappointment is a part of life, but God promises to guide us through the valleys.

For your I would like to borrow a biblical verse from Psalm 25:4-5, "Show me Your ways, O Lord, teach me Your paths; guide me in Your truth and teach me, for You are God my Savior, and my hope is in You all day long." The reason for having that verse is when life hands us a disappointment - whether it be a Deaf Lutheran church closure, a loss of pastor due to transfer to the hearing Lutheran church, decimating Lutheran members owing to death, losing members to different churches, and no emergence of new Lutheran Deaf children as their parents have preferred staying at their hearing churches. As a result, the attendance of international conventioneers biennially has been declining since Vancouver, British Columbia, Canada in 2005. What is happening to the Deaf church community now? To be blunt with my

We fast forward to the present because enrollment in schools for the deaf across North America is declining. Several deaf schools have closed down. The majority of deaf children are being educated in mainstream programs. Please open our arms to welcome the new breed of Deaf persons I mentioned earlier. Many of them may be not be of the "old school" Deaf culture, but they can bring with them a wide variety of gifts and talents that can be invested into the Deaf church community. As you are disappointed, God keeps His promises to be with you, support and encourage you. Talk to God and tell Him your disappointments as though you are at the loss. Be in the Word.

Remember, God's timing is not ours. Please wait with patience as God will open doors for you. God's Plan is always best for us. Looking at the wonderful Ghana and India mission projects with much success, we must continue to invest and support with God's Guidance. As we know, over thousands of Deaf Lutheran-converted natives aboard need our support. Finding a new creativity to move past the disappointments and setbacks is made easier knowing God is with us offering patience and acceptance. God shows us that His plan is always best. God bless all of you.

We would like to say a BIG thank-you to the wonderful host committee in Baltimore, Maryland for their success. The new president-elect Jeff Padon deserves God's blessing for his generous leadership. We are looking forward to the next host convention's planning in Rochester, New York in 2009 with God's Guidance.
