The lessons can be used for Sunday School, Bible study, and Vacation Bible School. They can be used for after-school religion classes or individual study at home. They can also be used for adult Bible study if needed.

The Bible lessons will be made available when they are completed and copied on DVDs/CDs. They will be distributed to all the deaf churches and churches with deaf ministry. Individuals can get a copy as well.

Mission Projects Fund. 2009 – 2011 Report The 2009 ILDA convention in Rochester, New York, voted as follows:

Rank # 1 – D.I.T. – Zechariah Fund (North America) (\$ 20,000)

Rank # 2 – Children & Youth Ministry at Jesus Lutheran Church of the Deaf, Austin, TX (\$ 2,500)

Rank # 3 – D.I.T. – Zechariah Fund (World) (\$ 10,000)

Rank # 4 – Youth Service Project (\$ 8,000)

Rank # 5 – Leadership Training Development (\$4,000)

Rank # 6 - Rev. Leber Deaf Lutheran Youth Camp (\$4,000)

Rank # 7 – Exhibit Booth Fund (Public Relations) (\$4,000)

Rank # 8 – Starfish Deaf Learning Center at Christ Lutheran Deaf Church (\$ 2,500 ) Grand Total (2009-2011) -- \$ 55,000

48 congregations, foundation, individual/couples and bequests have donated a total of \$49,723.00 so far. This means we are at 90.4% of our goal. My hope is that more will contribute \$5,277.00 or 9.6% within the next three months of May, June, and July, 2011 to reach our goal.

Please note that Ranking # 2 and Ranking # 4 showed a total of \$ 10,500.00 and this has been sent to Rev. Mark Seeger of Austin, Texas, in the fall season of 2010 and the winter season of 2011. Funds are available for Ranking # 1, # 3, # 5, & # 6.
