From the Pastoral Advisor



As a historian, I am trying to simplify and briefly explain how the reformation was started by Martin Luther because the

500th year anniversary is happening this year.

Martin Luther faithfully followed Church teachings and practices. However, he could not find peace of mind. He wondered how God judged his actions. While he studied the New Testament, he found the answer to the questions that had been troubling him. He decided that trusting in Jesus Christ, rather than doing good works, would save people from their sins. Luther's ideas brought him into conflict with the Church. In 1517, Pope Leo X wanted money to improve St. Peter's Church in Rome. The pope sent out monks to sell indulgences that Luther opposed. Luther believed the sale of indulgences led people to think they could buy God's forgiveness for their sins.

That night on October 31, 1517 Luther posted a list of 95 Theses on the door of the Castle Church in Wittenberg. In the list Luther stated that only God could forgive sins. He challenged anyone who disagreed to debate with him. He began to attack Catholic beliefs openly. He said that Popes could make mistakes, that the only true guide to religious truth was the Bible, which every Christian had the right to read; and that every Christian had the right to pray to God without the aid of a priest. Luther's ideas that the Catholic Church must improve, or be reformed, was accepted by many Germans and Europeans. As a result, many new churches were set up in Europe. Luther himself began a new church called the Lutheran Church.

This ILDA convention is just around the corner as Indianapolis will host a special celebration this summer of 2017. Again, I am encouraging all of you to please attend this historic convention as it is a once-in-your-lifetime opportunity because the 500th Anniversary celebration is a rarity. We are looking forward to learning more of God's Word during the convention.

We are strong believers of Martin Luther's belief in that we are liberated by grace. We believe we are called to be responsible citizens in God's world and good stewards of God's creation. We are freed by the grace of God to engage in this Christian ministry. As we celebrate this anniversary in 2017, we see it as opportunities to show family and friends God's love in Jesus Christ through acts of service and in our words.
