### Lutheran Deaf Mission Society (LDMS) News

#### DIT: Deaf Institute of Theology/EIIT Curriculum

- Becky Jungklaus received her deaconess certification from Concordia Seminary, St. Louis. She has a call to Lifebridge Community Lutheran Church, Sealy, TX.
- Two deaf men will complete their second year of study in the DIT/EIIT program.
- Two ladies from Kansas (deaf and hearing) are in their first year under the mentorship of a local pastor.
- One new deaf student will join the DIT program this fall.

#### Foreign Missions by Rev. Thomas Dunseth

LDMS has two ongoing and one future project opportunity. The first project is supporting the Evangelical Lutheran Church in Kenya and helping the pastor with his studies in deaf education to better serve the Deaf in his region. The second project is the India Evangelical Lutheran Church. Funds were requested to renovate their school properties. The deaf school was forced to close until further renovation was done. So, LDMS sent money to help complete the project. Third, a project for the Ethiopian Evangelical Church Mekane Yesus. A Church Interpreter Training program is greatly needed to serve the largest Deaf population in Ethiopia. Partnering with the Ephphatha Lutheran Mission society might be possible. It is pending right now.

## Thank you for your support!



A National LWML grant of \$47,000 was given to Ephphatha Lutheran Mission Society (ELMS) at the most recent LWML convention held in Milwaukee, WI. The grant supports two projects that we submitted. The first was to strengthen and expand the Church Interpreter Training Academy (CITA), formerly the **CITI** (Church Interpreter Training Institute It was something ELMS has been wanting to do for a long time but have not been able to. The need of the church is great as pastors and church workers and church leaders have found it is very difficult to get interpreters. Part of the reason is because the interpreters who are out there do not feel they have the

skills and understanding to interpret a worship service. So, this grant will help with four CITA programs for three years and will help to establish church interpreting workshops in four key areas.

The second project in the grant supports the translation of the Lutheran Service Book (LSB). ELMS has received many requests for good resources for interpreters and Deaf members. There are older resources for former lectionaries and hymnity but not much for the new hymnal. The project will be in video format, and will be done by a Deaf translation team and will be an online resource.
