#### You Will Know the Truth

31 So Jesus said to the Jews who had believed him, "If you abide in my

word, you are truly my disciples, 32 and you will know the truth, and the truth will set you free." John 8:31-32

These words are worth repeating in our time. Many think that there is no truth or if there is a truth no one has it all. But here Jesus gives a promise to all who believe in Him. We WILL know the truth and that truth WILL set us free.

First, Jesus promises that you will know the truth. This means you can have confidence about who God is. who you are, what he has done for you and what you should do now. God is Father, Son and Holy Spirit. Jesus proclaims this truth when He says, "Baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit." God is Father, Son and Holy Spirit who works to set us free from sin as Jesus says above. Iesus tells us we are slaves to sin because all who sin are slaves to sin. Do you sin? Then you are a slave and you will not remain in the house of God unless the Son sets you free. So Jesus tells you that He came to set you free from this sin that makes you a slave! That is what happens on the cross because Jesus takes all of your sins and the Father punishes Him for your sins.

Now Jesus can forgive you because He already took your punishment and gives you His righteousness. Finally Jesus tells us to continue in His Word, which will give you the truth and that truth will free you from sin to love others.

Second, Jesus promises that the truth will set you free. First we have confidence about who God is, who we are, what he has done for us and what we are to do now all through the knowledge of the truth. But now Jesus tells us that the truth will DO something to us. Here Jesus claims that His Word delivers freedom from sin by giving you the gift of forgiveness that He won on the cross through His crucifixion. If you want to find Jesus and you want Him to forgive you, then go to His Word. Every time you read the Word of God in the Bible, Jesus is setting you free. Every time you go to church and hear the Word of God proclaimed by the pastor, Jesus is setting you free. Every time you receive the Lord's Supper, Jesus is setting you free. Every time vou talk about Jesus with your brothers and sisters in Christ, Jesus is setting you free. Free from what? Free from sin. If you are free from sin than you are free from death. If you are free from death than you are eternally alive! If you are free from sin you are united to the heavenly Father! All of this happens when you remain in the Word of Jesus found in the Bible and in the mouths of Pastors and in the mouths of Christians.

If you are a disciple of Jesus, you will know the truth and the truth

will set you free. So how do you know you are a disciple? You remain in the Word of Jesus. Dear brothers and sisters in Christ, the world does not know the truth because the Word of Jesus does not find a place in the world. Satan will continue to try and confuse us. He will persecute us and attack us. The world will hate us! But none of that changes that fact that we are Jesus' disciples when we remain in the word. We know the truth! We are free! Live in this freedom dear brothers and sisters in Christ, now and always.

#### **Registration**

Please note there are two choices for registration: ILDA members and non-members. ILDA members must put their 2020-2022 membership number on the registration form. Non-members will have to pay increased costs. All convention registration forms received will follow the postmark date on the envelope for the cost. If you wish to only attend the banquet, there is a separate line item for that. <u>No registrations accepted after June</u> <u>15th due to food count total requirements by</u> <u>the hotel and possible post office delivery delays.</u>

The combo ticket includes a registration fee (\$20) and all meals (Thursday night reception to breakfast on Sunday).

There will be no money collected for ILDA membership dues on this 2021 convention registration form. You will need to fill out the separate ILDA membership form and send it with your payment to David Brown prior to the ILDA 2021 convention. The new ILDA membership year is 10/1/2020—9/30/2022.
