26th Biennial 2021 ILDA Convention Report

The 26th Biennial ILDA convention was held July 22-25, 2021 at the Holiday Inn in Elk Grove Village, Illinois. The convention, for the first time, was hosted by an out-of-state deaf congregation, Prince of Peace Lutheran Church for the Deaf, Spring Lake Park, Minnesota. The theme for the convention was "Remember-Celebrate—Proclaim" based on Psalm 89:15 "Blessed are the people who know the festal shout, who walk, O Lord, in the light of Your face."

Convention chair was Janet Gehlbach, assisted by Rev. Daryl Gehlbach, and committee members: John Mason, Carolyn Snyder-Mason, Rev. Ron Friedrich, Carissa Huffman, Rev. Tim Eckert, Paula Willig, Lynda Nix, and Rev. Mark Willig with special supporting staff of Sharon Brown and Diane Francisco.

Daily convention devotions were led by Rev. Daryl Gehlbach, Rev. Mark Seeger and Rev. Dr. John Reinke. Workshop presenters were: Rev. Dr. John Reinke ("Online Technologies"), Bob Lenderman/Rev. Ron Friedrich ("Job Openings—Don't Sit On Your Hands, Get Involved"), Rev. Edwin Bergstresser ("How Do We Share Jesus' Story?), Rev. William Ludwig ("A Deaf Pastor's Perspective on the History of ILDA"), and Rev. Ron Friedrich ("Training for

Service"). All devotions and workshops were well received by the attendees.

Interpreted Ministry Conference (IMC) presenters were Carissa Huffman ("Interpreted Ministry in a Remote Context: Interpreting Worship on Video"), Paula Willig ("What We Have Seen With Our Hands: Making The Message Visual"), and Rev. Dr. John Reinke ("Online Technologies") — joint session with IMC and ILDA.

On Thursday evening, Janet Gehlbach (2021 chair) invited the Lutheran Church Charities K-9 comfort dogs to give a presentation to the attendees. They had the opportunity to greet the two dogs present. Their handlers/trainers explained how they go out to crisis events to have the dogs give comfort to the workers and volunteers.

Janet Gehlbach gave a presentation on the ILDA banner—its creation, history and photos of the two banners. The first one was "retired" and given to Concordia Historical Institute in St. Louis. The second banner is currently in use at the ILDA conventions.

On Friday night, Rev. Daryl Gehlbach did a trivia presentation of questions and answers of LC-MS Deaf history and also ILDA history. It was very interesting to learn some of our history.

Saturday night entertainment was the "Magic" Morgan magician show with Matthew Morgan and Liliana Morgan from Wisconsin. They were very entertaining and because they are from Wisconsin there were quite a few people in the audience who knew them!

A photo booth was set up for attendees to take selfies. The backdrop was the North Avenue beach view of the Chicago skyline. There was also a sign made in front with the convention logo and location and dates of the 26th Biennial convention. Many thanks to Richard Belling, Our Savior Lutheran Church, Madison, WI, for helping get the

ball rolling in ordering the supplies for the photo booth and to Tim Schoor, Wells Print and Digital Services, Madison, WI, for donating and printing the large sign in the front. Because of COVID-19 issues it was decided that there would be no shared items (hats, boas, other decorative items to hold). If people wanted their photo with a hat, etc. then they needed to bring their own.

Three (3) service projects were done during the convention. The first one was fifty (50) blessing bags put together of toiletries (toothbrush, toothpaste, body wash, hand lotion, deodorant, hand sanitizer, wipes, shampoo, kleenex, wash cloth), life savers candy, cookies and trail mix. The bags were given to Rev. Jason Pankau at Chicago Hope Church in Chicago, Illinois. The second service project was attendees writing down their favorite memories of ILDA conventions to be typed up into the ILDA 50th Anniversary History Book. The third service project was hand written cards of thanks to military people and given to Packages 4 Patriots (P4P), a non-profit group based out of The Lutheran Church of the Holy made and beautifully done by Spirit in Elk Grove Village. Randy Mode received the thank you cards and was very appreciative of our efforts to help his organization because many times they do not have enough cards to send with the care packages overseas. It was our intention to have a group go over to the church to help pack care packages but, because of COVID, only the P4P Board members are able to pack them.

Mission Projects were voted on for 2021-2024. This list is on the last page of this issue.

During the banquet, Master of Ceremony, Tim Kearney, kept things moving along smoothly and entertained us with laughter. was a "Ask the Pastors" session

The Opening Prayer was given by Rev. Tim Eckert. ILDA President, John Mason, gave the toast to celebrate ILDA's 50th Anniversary with a "raise your glass" of sparking apple juice with each other. John Mason also gave out "President's Prerogative Awards" to Patrick Sell (past ILDA Treasurer), David G. Brown (past ILDA Treasurer and Deaf Lutheran Editor) and Larry Ginter (past ILDA Deaf Lutheran Business Manager).

Rev. Daryl Gehlbach showed a power point presentation of the pastoral and church worker anniversaries. The Right Hand Award was given to Howard E. Snyder, Toledo, OH. Janet Gehlbach recognized past ILDA host chairpersons by having them up on stage. Past and present ILDA officers were also recognized on stage.

There were no skits or choir competition at the convention. Only one banner was made and awarded 1st place to Redeemer Lutheran Church, Olathe, Kansas. They received a cash prize of \$50.00. Door prizes were given out by Mark/Linda Johnson and Janet Gehlbach. A few of the door prizes were hand several people: Becky Jungklaus (quilted Bible book bag) and Becky Catchpole (two sets of colored notecards and a large framed painted picture of a cross with "I Love You" design on it).
